the time together and apart - it ministered to the soul.


I found that the day "fed" me

The course will explore the 'The Whole Easter Story' by Jo Swinney.


'Through Bible readings, reflections and stories, discover how the cross transforms not just our own individual connection with Jesus, but also our relationships with each other and our world.'
